2024 Rules & Regulations

- 1. Riders/Parents/Trainers will be held responsible for being familiar and abide by the 2024 Class/Division Specifications and Rules & Regulations for all MSC Horse Shows
- 2. This show is presented under the guidelines of USEF rules. Where these rules do not apply, decisions of the show management will be binding.
- 3. Class/Division Specifications not adhered to may result in expulsion from classes and/or loss of points.
- 4. Riders who have advanced into a new division may not return to a lesser division without first consulting MSC Horse Shows Management
- 5. Management reserves the right to refuse or to receive an exhibitor and/or horse before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any exhibitor or horse without being liable for compensation.
- 6. Any act of discourtesy to a judge or any other official of the show on the part of an owner, trainer, rider, or groom will immediately disqualify any horse or horses with whom they are associated. Any entry fees for such horse(s) will be forfeited.
- 7. All exhibitors (riders and/or handlers) are required to be current members to
- compete and for points to count or pay a non-member fee.
- 8. Proof of a current Coggin and vaccines will be required for each horse entering the showgrounds.
- 9. All riders must wear approved helmets while on showgrounds.
- 10. Entries received after 12am the Sunday before the show will be considered a late entry and charged a late entry fee. Any partial entry will be considered a late entry.
- 11. Stalls will be available by reservation. Stall reservations received after 12am the Sunday before the show will be considered a late stall and charged a late stall fee.
- 12. No show numbers will be issued, or schooling allowed until a signed entry and a blank check has been received by the show office.
- 13. Returned checks will be assessed at \$25.00 for each re-deposit to the bank.
- 14. Dogs must always be kept on a leash and not create a disturbance.
- 15. Any persons operating a motor vehicle on showgrounds are required to have a valid driver's license. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license will not be permitted to operate golf carts, scooters, motorbikes, or farm utility vehicles.
- 16. No alcohol permitted on the showgrounds.
- 17. Three refusals will eliminate the rider from class.
- 18. A 3-minute gate call will be strictly enforced.
